day of my death together with all my land and plantation lying
between the river and if I were to be long living part of the land
and plantation lying between the river and if I were to be long living

I do hereby declare that I do hereby give and bequeath unto my
beloved wife all my personal Estate to and
remain in the possession and under the Management & Direction of my
dear wife until my son William come to age and then to be Disposed
of as she shall think right That my Daughter Mary be paid out of my
Estate thirty pounds current money and that she Immediately after my
Death have her Mother's Side Saddle of Gold ring & Silver to her That my
Daughter Elizabeth have five pounds paid her when my son William
comes to age And that all the residue of my Estate after my debts
are paid & give to be Equally Divided Amongst my beloved wife John
Edward & William Canniffax and do Appoint my dear wife and
John Canniffax Executors of this my last will & testament & revoke
all wills by me heretofore made in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this Seventh day of February 1752
