in the Colony of Virginia to her and her Heirs forever except  
my said Frances should be with Child at the Time of my  
Death then & in such Case I give all my said Estate to such  
Child and his or her Heirs after the Decease of my Wife  
if she should prove with Child at Time of my Death and  
such Child should die without Issue then I give all my Estate

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if she should prove with Child at Time of my Death with  
which Child should be without issue then I give all my Estate  
bequeathed to my said Wife Frances and her Heirs forever  
~~and in my Will that my Executors should~~

to the said University all my lands and other Estate in Maryland or  
Virginia out of this Colony for such which I give in the same

manners and have given my other Estate in the Colony of Virginia  
during my life that my Executors pay unto my grandchildren, to-wit

Henry Charles Robert Bernard Sabilla James and Samuel

Each the sum of ten Pounds each to be laid out on my said

grandchildren as my Executors shall think most proper.

And lastly I do appoint my loving Wife Frances Barlyle

Friends Nephew Nathaniel Lord John Park Anthony

and my Cousin John Barlyle Executors of this my last Will

Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by me formerly

In Maryland whereof I have hitherto set my hand and aff
