that my Manns Plantation be Equally divided between my two
Sons Benjamin Harris and William Harris and all the
rest of my Estate to be Equally divided between my three Brothers
Benjamin Harris and William ^{Harris} and John. My Will
that if my son John Harris should desire to change his Guardian
that he might have his Guardian that he has any Reason of
my Estate until my said son John Harris is of the Age of Twenty one
years.

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I have of my own free will and full intention until my said son dies
