and Testament in manner and form following

First I will that my wife Sarah Jones have and Enjoy such part of  
my Estate as by Law is used, in case not otherwise provided for, but she  
shall have an Equal part of the Rest in my Estate out of the  
Residue to each of my Sons

And my will and desire is that all my Just Debts be paid out of  
Money Arising from any part of my Estate of necessity as the  
direction of my Executors hereafter named.

Item my will and desire is that all my Lands be Equally divided as  
near as may be by my said Executors between all my sons that may  
be living at the time of my Death having Regard to the Quality  
of such Land.

Item I give and bequeath to all my children both sons & Daughters

nothing arising from any part of my Estate if necessary as the  
direction of my Executors hereafter named.

Now my last and desire is that all my Lands be Equally divided as  
near as may be by my said Executors between all my sons that may  
be living at the time of my Death having regard to the Quality  
of such Land.

Now I give and bequeath to all my children both sons & Daughters  
their heirs and assigns for ever be Equally divided among them by my  
said Executors all my Estate not herein before disposed of Except my  
Daughter Maryanna Jones who has Received Two hundred and thirty  
Seven Acres of Land which is to be taken out of her part of my <sup>part</sup> ~~part~~ <sup>estate</sup> also  
one Feather Bed and furniture one hunting shabole two Iron pots one  
skillet one Fryng pan two Dishes two Basins and six plates one chest  
which is to be taken out of her part of my household Furniture also one Cow  
and Calf two Sheep one sow and pigs which is to be taken out of

part of my stock

lastly I do hereby and appoint my son Harrison Jones, Anderson Hughes and Thomas Nelson Executors of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto

set my hand and affixed my seal this 30th day of October 1779.
