county of Cumberland being of weak body but of a sound and perfect mind
and memory and knowing his appointment for all men once to die I do
ordain declare & confirm this my last will and testament in manner
following. First I deliver my soul into the hands of Almighty God
as first the hands of a faithful creator and my body to the dust to be
buried in a christian manner as my executors shall think fit and as to

my movable goods which God has been pleased to give me I give and bequeath
them in the following manner I purpoise

First I lend to my dear and beloved wife Mary Reynolds all my estate real &
personal to her during her widowhood not to be disturb'd.

Then I give and bequeath to my two sons Charles and Elisha the tract of land
whereon I live for my son Charles to have his first choice equally in the 2^d tract
of land.

Then I give and bequeath all my goods chattels stock and negroes to be equally
divided amongst my children hereafter named Biddy Mary Charles Martha
Sarah Elisha Anna Saroma.

Then I give and bequeath the tract of land whereon my mother lives lying in
Newport county after her death to be sold to the highest bidder and the money
to be divided amongst the children above mentioned.

And I do by this my last will and testament appoint my dear wife Mary
Reynolds and my son Charles Reynolds and Samuel Taylor my executors to
pay my debts & receive my debts and to see that this my last will and testam-
ent be fully and fairly and impartially acted according to true intent and
liberal meaning of the above words and to revoke disclaim and disannul
all four wills whatever to all I set my hand and seal this 22^d day
of March 1760.

At a court held for Cumberland county 22nd October 1770.
This last will and testament of John Reynolds deceased was proved by Benjamin Jarvis a witness thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Charles Reynolds one of the executors therein named who made oath answering to law certificate was granted him for obtaining probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon he together with Samuel Taylor his security entered into bond with condition according to law and liberty is reserved to the other executors to join in probat.
