unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Thomson all my Estate both real
and personal during her Widowhood to have and enjoy occupy &
dispose willy part and parcel thereof during her continuance in
single life and widowhood as said is and no longer for her support
and maintenance for boarding cloathing & schooling my son John

Thomson till he arrives at the age of Twenty one years
and if my said Wife Elizabeth Thomson should hereafter marry
I give in that Case I give and bequeath unto my said son
John Thomson the sum of £100

in my said last Case I give and bequeath unto my said Son
John David Thompson all my Estate both real and personal
and all that he has for ever & further my Will and pleasure
is that my said Son should receive without any lawfully begotten
children of his Body then my Negroes David & Kate with their
increase shall revert to my said Wife and be her property
and use. And all the remaining part of my Estate both
real and personal I give unto my Brother William Morris
to have and use as his property for ever. And I hereby constitute &
appoint my Father Josiah Thompson & Thomas Nash your
executors of this my last will and Testament. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand this fifth
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and eighty five.

The last Will and Testament of John Thompson deceased was
presented in Court by Jacob Thompson one of the Executors therein
named and proved by Christopher Wheat and Jacob Thompson Jur-
ors of the County of Meigs and ordered to be recorded. And on the
motion of the said Executor who made oath according to Law
Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due
form. Giving Security Whereupon he with Thomas Thompson
Jrann his Security entered into Bond according to Law.
Liberty is returned to the other Executors to join in proof.
