dispose willy part and parcel thereof during her continuance in
single life and widowhood as said is and no longer for her support
and maintenance for boarding cloathing & schooling my son John
Thomson till he arrives at the age of Twenty one years
After my said Wife Elizabeth Thomson should hereafter marry
I give in that Case I give and bequeath unto my said Son
John Thomson all my Estate both real and personal

And now in that Case I give and bequeath unto my said Son
John David Thompson all my Estate both real and personal
which I have and his heirs for ever & further my Will and pleasure
that my said Son should be without any lawfully begotten
son of his Body then my Nephews David & Kate with their
wives shall revert to my said Wife and be her property
for ever. And all the remaining part of my Estate both
real and personal I give unto my Brother William & Morris
Thompson as his property for ever. And I hereby constitute &
appoint my Father Josiah Thompson & Thomas Nash executors
of this my last will and Testament. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand this fifth
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and eighty five.
