I, William being visited with sickness of Greenland County and Parish of Hingham
well & Reason being visited with sickness of my body and calling to mind
because the uncertainty of all time of this mortal life by the grace
of God being now of sound and perfect mind and memory present
be to God therefore I do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following viz, I resign
my soul to God that gave it in hopes of pardon and remission of
my sins in and through the merits of and passion of my Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be put in the ground at the
discretion of my hereafter mentioned Executors. Then I give and
bequeath unto my Grandson Anthony Martin one Negro Man named
Peter to him and his heirs forever in case my Grand Son Anthony
Martin should die before he comes to the age of twenty one years
my desire is that Negro mentioned already in my Will should
belong unto my Grand Son John Martin to him and his heirs for
ever and the rest of my Estate to be equally divided between my
four Grand sons Anthony Martin John Martin and Peter Martin
and George Smith sons of my Daughter Narcissa the Estate of

business John Throst and my body to be put in the ground at
the discretion of my here by mentioned Executors. Item I give and
bequeath unto my Grandson Anthony Martin one Negro Man named
Peter to him and his heirs forever in case my Grand Son Anthony
Martin should die before he comes to the age of twenty one years
my desire is that Negro mentioned already in my Will should
return unto my Grandson John Martin to him and his heirs for
ever and the rest of my Estate to be equally divided between
four Grand sons Anthony Martin John Martin ^{John} Peter Martin
and George Smith sons of my Daughter Mary Ann the Estate of
my husband Anthony Martin of any money should fall to me
from any of my Relations from Holland or France or England
or any other parts I give and impute the same to be divided
in two equal parts for my son Daniel Perrow and Mary Perrow
the other two parts for the Children of my Daughter
Margaret Ann and Margaret and I do appoint Daniel Perrow
my Executor to be Executor of this my last Will and

At a meeting of the Vestry of the Church of St. Andrew the Elder
