

In the name of God Amen I Mark Andrews of the Parish of
Dunstable in the County of Bedford being in good health and of
sound mind and memory thanks be to almighty God, and knowing
the uncertainty of this earthly life do make and declare this my
last will and testament in manner and form following Viz. wishing
and meaning as all will or wives by me formerly made first I
commend my soul to almighty God in whom and by the merits
of Jesus Christ I trust and believe to be saved and my body to be buried
in such a decent and Christian like manner as my Executors or
successors shall think fit and as for temporal estate and
things which God hath been pleased to bestow upon me I give and bequeath
as follows Item I give and bequeath unto my three sons John, Thomas
and William Andrews the Land and plantation that I have in
County Bedford to be equally divided between these my three sons
I give it to them and their Heirs for ever and if either of these my
sons should die without Heir my will is that it should be divided
between the surviving sons. Item I give and bequeath unto my
two sons William and Watt Andrews the Land and plantation which
I now have to be equally divided between these my two sons I give
it to them and their Heirs for ever if either of these my sons should
die without Heir my will is that the other surviving son should

have it I give it to him and his ^{Heirs} for ever Item I give and bequeath
unto my son Jesse Andrews twenty shillings sterling he having
been rewarded by me Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Mary ^{of} twenty shillings sterling she having been rewarded
by me Item I give unto my four sons William, Thomas, James
and John Andrews twenty five pounds Current money for each of
them I give it to them and their Heirs for ever Item I give and
bequeath unto my daughter Susanna Andrews one Negro
girl named Pender and five pounds Current money of Virginia
I give it to her and her Heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto
my daughter Ann Andrews one Negro girl named Lucy I
give it to her and her Heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto
my eight Children John Andrews, William Andrews, Thomas
Andrews, James Andrews, John Andrews, Hannah Andrews,
Susanna Andrews and Ann Andrews all my Negroes Chattels
and household stuff and all the rest of my personal estate after
all my debts are paid to be equally divided between these my eight
Children I give it to them and their Heirs for ever Item I
constitute and appoint my son John P. and William
Andrews Executors of this my last will and testament
and I hereby authorize them to execute and seal this

with a copy of the same to the Clerk of the Court in the case of the same
