ory thanketh Almighty God and calling to remembrance the uncer-
tain estate of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield
unto death when it shall please God to call, do make and declare
this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
first I commend my soul unto Almighty God my saviour and redeem-
er whom and by whose merits I trust and believe myself to be
saved and to have full remission and forgiveness of all my sins and
to inherit the kingdom of heaven, and my body I bequeath to the
earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor hereaf-
ter named and for the settling of my temporal estate, and such
goods chattels and Debts as it hath pleased God to bestow upon me
I do give and give and dispose the same in manner and form
following (Viz) I bequeath to my son William
Humbleton my negro woman Betty, and all her increase my ne-
gro woman Dinah and all her Increase my negro Girls Jane and
Mary and all their Increase to him and his Heirs forever
and all my stock of cattle and hogs three feather beds and fu-
rther two chests two trunks one Table together with all my
household furniture and Coven furniture

and all their Increase to him and his Heirs forever
and all my stock of cattle and hogs three feather beds and four
chests two trunks one Table together with all my
household furniture and kitchen furniture unto my said son
William Hambleton and his Heirs forever and that my said
son William Hambleton at my decease to have full Power and
sole and Plurable Disposition of the same and that without
any delay or further delay and I do hereby make
and declare my said son William Hambleton full and so-
le executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
and annulling & making void all former Wills and bequests by me
made and declaring this only to be my last will and Testament.

the 1st day of October one thousand seven hundred and fifty
