At a court held for Cumberland county 22nd April 1782.

This last will and testament of Nancy Bond deceased was exhibited in court by
Samuel Holloway one of the executors therein named proved by Clement Brown
Wright Bond two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion
of the said executor who swore according to law certificate is granted him for
obtaining probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon he with John
Mecor his security entered into bond according to law and liberty is reserved
to the other executor to join in probate.
