

I Robert Hughes being at this present
in perfect health and strength and sound sense and
of sound memory do hereby and avoweth this present writing to
be my last will and Testament in manner and form as followeth
knowing and considering all other Wills before by me made
after my first Wife's death and my several Charges & Buriall I give
the Third of my Estate as followeth.

Firstly I give and bequeath to my first Daughter Sarah Hudson one Shilling Sterling.

Secondly I give to my second Daughter Mary Hudson one Shilling Sterling.

Thirdly I give to my third Daughter Martha Walter one Shilling Sterling.

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my fourth Daughter Susanna Hughes a good
well furnished Feather Bed, and a Horse Bridle and Saddle to the Value
of ten Pounds and also my Muttall's Gait Betty & my Negro Woman
Ann the householdes I bought at my Brother's Executors out here and
being found in cash.

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my fifth Daughter Temperance Hughes two
Negroes namely Hannah and Matthey and their future increase to
her and her heirs for ever and after my Wife's decease or Marriage
I give to the Child aforesaid my Negro Man Tom to her and

I give to the Child aforesaid my Negro Man Soudun to her and her
heirs for ever.

Lastly I leave the Land Housing and Plantation whereon I now live to the
only use of my loving Wife Martha Hughes during her Natural Life
or Widowhood and after her Decease or Marriage I leave the Land
aforesaid to the only use of my Son Abraham Hughes during his
Natural Life and after his decease I give the Land aforesaid to the
Heirs of his Body lawfully begotten and in defect of such an
Heir I give the Land aforesaid to my son Robert Hughes to him and to
his heirs for ever.

Finally I leave the Land Housing and Plantations I should and before
my death take the Mouth of Muddy Creek to the only behoof and use of
my loving Wife Martha Hughes during her Natural Life or Widow-
hood and after her Decease or Marriage I give the Land aforesaid
to my son Robert Hughes and to the Heirs of his Body
lawfully begotten.

And I leave to the use of my loving Wife Martha Hughes all my
household goods and all my household goods and all
other of my movable goods.

Legio Roman, before mentioned, and I leave to my Daughter
Susannah Hughes fifty pounds more than before given,
and the same execution still as before mentioned. Witness my
hand and Seal this twenty fifth day of October 1752.
