Item I give to my daughter Martha Holland my safe, silver jack, and for the rest of my estate I would have it sold and equally divided amongst all my children (viz) Clement Brown, Sarah Wainfree, Mary Weatherford, Martha Holland, Elizabeth Smith, Nancy Brown, and Rachel Bradley.

Lastly I appoint the Suggs Hill and Clement Brown executors of this my last will and testament In testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this 18th day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight.
