must yield to death when it shall please God to call or make constitute
ordain and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form
following revoking and annulling by these presents all and every Testament
and testaments will and Wills heretofore by me made and declared either
by word or writing and this is to be taken only for my last will and in-
testament and none other and first being penitent and sorry from the
bottom of my heart for my sins past most humbly desiring forgiveness
for the same I do Commit my soul unto almighty God my saviour
and Redeemer in whom and by the merits of Jesus Christ I trust and
believe assuredly to be saved and to have full Remission and forgiveness of
all my sins and that my soul with my body at a general day of
Resurrection shall rise again with joy and through the merits of Christ
death and passion possess and inherit the Kingdom ^{of Heaven} prepared for his
elect and chosen and my body to be buried in such place where it
please my executors hereafter named to appoint and now for ^{the} settling
my temporal estate and such goods Chattels and debts as it hath
pleased God far above my deserts to bestow upon me. I do order give
and dispose the same in manner and form following that is to wit

first I will that all those debts and dues as I owe in right or conscience
to any manner of person or persons whatsoever shall be well and
truly contented and paid or ordained to be paid within convenient
time after my decease by my executor hereafter named. Item I
give and bequeath unto Jane Scott seventy five acres of Land lying
in Cumberland County and bounded as follows on Wm Bond on Robert
Smith John Chambers John Plazant Jacob Winferry Wm Hughes also
I do bequeath to Jane Scott her Chaur of Cattel six head also ten head
of Hogs her Chaur also her equal part of the House hold goods also one
horse and wheel I do give and bequeath to the said Jane Scott and
her Heirs by free born begotting or Wedlock for ever. and if the said Jane
Scott should die without an heir begotting by ^{free born} her husband the
estate ~~the estate~~ to go to Ann Scott her sister and so to her heirs
for ever. Item I give and bequeath to Ann Scott mother Jan's her
Chaur of Cattel three head also Ann Scott to have six hog, her Chaur
and her equal part of the house hold goods also the said Ann Scott to
live on the said plantation of mine so long as ^{she} shall keep single also
the said Ann Scott to have her equal part of what shall arise from
my estate if so be any interests shall arise from it for the
maintenance of the said Jane Scott also I do give my wife Jane
a slave belonging to John Marymon one Feather bed her Chaur
and after all these I am to be paid to them

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time after my decease by my executors hereafter named. Item I
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Smith John Chambers John Pleasant Jacob Winferry Wm Hughes also
I do bequeath to Jane Scott her Chous of Cattel six head also ten head
of Hogs her Chous also her equal part of the House goods also one
horse and wheel I do give and bequeath to the said Jane Scott and
her Heirs by free born begotting or Wedlock for ever and if the said Jane
Scott should die without an heir begotting by free born Husband the
estate ~~the estate~~ to go to Ann Scott her sister and so to her heirs
for ever. Item I give and bequeath to Ann Scott mother Jan's her
Chous of Cattel three head also Ann Scott to have six hogs her Chous
and her equal part of the house goods also the said Ann Scott to
live on the said plantation of mine so long as ^{she} shall keep single also
the said Ann Scott to have her equal part of what shall arise from
my estate if so be any interests shall arise from so for the
maintenance of the said Jane Scott also I do give my wife Jane
a slave belonging to John Marymon one Feather bed her Chous
and after all these forementioned have got the above given then

by my wife I am belonging to John Maymon and I do acknowledge to be in
my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set too
my hand and has fixed my seal this seventeenth day of June and the Year
of our Lord Jesus one thousand seven hundred fifty and four.
