earth from whence it came to be buried at the Discretion of my
executors hereafter named as to my worldly Estate what it hath
pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me after my debts and
Funeral Charges is paid I give as follows.

First I give and bequeath to my Brother James Harris one Negro
Woman named Hannah and her increase to him and to his
Heirs forever and still.

Secondly I give and bequeath to my Brother Benjamin Harris one
Negro man named Jubster to him and to his Heirs forever.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my Brother William Harris one
Negro girl named Rachel a boy named Mung with their
increase to him and to his Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath my sole to Almighty God who gave
me being through the Merits of my Dear Saviour Jesus Christ to
live full and free pardon for all my sins and my Body to the
Church from whence it came to be buried at the Discretion of my
Executors hereafter named as to my worldly Estate what it hath
pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me after my debts and
Funeral charges is paid I give as follows.

First I give and bequeath to my Brother James Harris one Negro
Woman named Hannah and her increase to him and to his
Heirs forever.

Second I give and bequeath to my Brother Benjamin Harris one
Negro Man named Jubster to him and to his Heirs forever.

Third I give and bequeath to my Brother William Harris one
Negro Man named Jack and a very young one with their
increase to him and to his Heirs forever.

Fourth I give and bequeath to my Brother John Harris one
Negro Man named Sam to him and to his Heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to my Sister Mary James Ten Poundsterling
Guarantee Money to her and to her Heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath to my Sister Elizabeth Patrick Ten Poundsterling
Guarantee Money to her and to her Heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath to my Sister Anne Booth Ten Poundsterling
Guarantee Money to her and to her Heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath to Anne Elizabeth Flounoy one feather bed
and Furniture to her and to her Heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath to my three Brothers James Harris, Benjamin
Harris and William Harris to be equally divided amongst them all my
other books that I may have and which I have not already bequeathed to
them and their Heirs for ever and they shall pay each their proportion-
able Part to raise the money to pay of their Sisters Legacy I order

that no part of my Estate be appraised and I make my said
