groes. Viz. Baffie Betty Annice Savoy Dick Davis Sam Petty and Aggy
and all there increase to her & her heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my grandson Stephen Davenport son of
Stephen Davenport deceased forty pounds current money of Virginia to him
and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my ^{grand} daughter Molly Davenport daughter to
Stephen Davenport deceased forty pounds current money of Virginia to
