

In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Devereux of the County of Hillston
and County of Limerick being perfectly in my senses do make this my
last will and testament in witnesses whereof I have subscribed

My negro boy Jerry that I have agreed to let my son James Devereux
have and he agrees to take for his part in full of all my estate and my
account against him to be regarded in confirmation of the said agreement.
It is my will and desire that no claim for any debt due me be brought against
my said son James Devereux and that in consideration of his part in full
of all my other estate I give unto my said son James Devereux my said ne-
gro boy Jerry and all his debt due me to him and his heirs forever and my
said son James is not to have any other part of my estate after my decease.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Devereux my negro man
Dick that he have of me and the hire due to this time and also his account
due me to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Devereux my negro woman
Sabby that he have of me and all her increase and the hire due to this time
and also his account due me to him and his heirs forever.

Item The hundred acres of land and plantation that I have made a deed for
unto my son Julius Devereux he agrees and it is in consideration of his
part in full of all my other estate and as I have made him a deed for
the same and given him possession of the said one hundred acres of land

the same and I do hereby certify that the said Julius Deserpont is not to have any other part of my estate after my decease.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my son William Deserpont my negro man George that he have of me and the hire due to me and also his accout due me to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my grandson William Deserpont son of my son Stephen dec'd the sum of five shillings current money when he shall arrive at lawful age to him & his heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Brissilla Glen my negro man Cuffy that he have of me and the hire to him due to her and his heirs forever. And my negro woman Betty and all her increase that is now in the possession of Green Glen. I lend unto my daughter Brissilla Glen and to her husband Edson Glen during their natural lives and after their decease I give my said negro woman Betty and all her increase to be equally divided between all the several children of my daughter Brissilla Glen to each of them and their heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my grandson Stephen Deserpont son of my son Stephen dec'd the sum of forty pounds current money and also unto my grand daughter Melley Deserpont the sum of forty pounds current money to them and their heirs forever; and that the said legacies to my above said grand children be and remain in the

hereinbefore, and Henry Davenport until my said grandson Stephen son
of my son Stephen shall be twenty one years old and then that my said
son Henry pay the said sum of forty pounds left with him in trust
unto my said grandson Stephen and also the sum of forty pounds
unto my said grand daughter as above.

Item My will and desire is that after all my just debts and funeral
expences are paid that the remainder part of my estate, my negroes Jude
Bernard, Peter, Billy, and Lerina and all my other effects whatsoever
that is not before given in this my will, be appraised by my executors
hereafter named, and by them sold to the highest bidder amongst those
selors and the rest of my children and the hole amount by such sale
or appraisement and the sum due me which shall by them be collected
be equally divided between my sons Thomas Davenport Henry Daven-
port and William Davenport and my daughter Drusilla Glean to
each of them and theirs heirs forever. And that there be no other
appraisment.

Lastly I appoint my sons Thomas Davenport Henry Davenport & and
William Davenport and Gideon Glean executors of this my last will &
testament hereby revoking disannulling all former wills by me made
and declaring this to be my last will & testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal twenty near the day of Decemr 1771

and declaring this to be my last will & testament. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal twenty ninth day of December
in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and seventy
four.
