Cumberland being sick and weak of body but in perfect mind and
memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner
following to wit;

Item I give and bequeath to my son Stephen Lockett all my land
in Prince Edward county on the south side of Hawkes creek to the
road to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Abner Lockett the land where I now
live to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Jacob Lockett all my land on
Nuttree branch in Charles City county to him and his heirs forever.
If he shall come to the age of twenty one years if not it shall be sold
to the highest bidder and the money to be equally divided
amongst all my children. As also I give him fifteen pounds cur-
rent money one feather bed and furniture a horse saddle and
the four wheels.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Bays all my land on
the north side of Hawkes creek from the crop line of my son Stephen
to the upper line to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Stone all the land

on the south side of the north fork of Telling creek as shown by a map,
of the north side ^{map} beginning at the bottom line, thence up the creek to
include the following acres to wit and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Lockett one feather
bed and furniture and fifteen pounds current money.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Gypson one feather
bed and furniture and fifteen pounds current money.

Item I give my well beloved wife Judith Lockett twenty pounds
current money if she will relinquish her right of my estate.

It is my desire that all the land I hold in Prince Edward county not
already sold may be sold and the money equally divided amongst
all my children except my son James Lockett. It is further my
desire that all the rest of my estate of every nature and kind whether
real or both real and personal be equally divided amongst all my
children that is to say James Stephen David Abner and Jacob Lockett
Martha Bees Lucy Anne Mary Gypson Elizabeth Lockett.

I also desire my estate may not be appraised.

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my son Stephen Lockett Abner
Lockett and Arthur Mosley Exrs. of this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all other wills by me formerly made In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 1st day of

This last will and testament of Thomas Lockett deceased was exhibited in
court by Stephen Lockett and Ebenezer Lockett two of the executors therein
named and the same was proved by Gideon Lockett and Robert Haskins
two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion
of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted
them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security
whereupon they together with Arthur Mofley and Gideon Lockett their
security entered into bond according to law and liberty is reserved to the
other executor to join in probat.
