land County being in perfect health and memory Thanks be to
God Do make this Will and Testament hereby Revoking
and Disannulling all and every other wills by me heretofore
made do ratify and confirm this to be my last and Testament
in manner and form following, first I give and bequeath my
Soul to God that gave it and my body to the earth to be de-
cently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter. Namely

Iam. I give and bequeath to my Son Moses Arnolds two hundred Acres
of Land being the Land and Plantations whereon he and I now
live to him and his heirs forever.

Iam. I give and bequeath to my Son William Arnolds one hundred Acres
of Land being of Land and Plantation whereon he now lives
to him and his heirs forever.

Iam. I give and bequeath to my Son Thomas Arnolds one hundred
Acres of Land being the Land ^{and} Plantation whereon he now lives

Iam. I give to my Son Moses Arnolds one large & better Dutch
one large & better Bacon.

Iam. I give to my Son Henry Arnolds one Cow.

Iam. I leave unto my loving wife Elisabeth Arnolds y^e full

all my estate real and personal during her lifetime
further my Will is that after her Death that all my estate
of Negroes Stock and household goods be equally divided
amongst all my Children.

Lastly I nominate and appoint three Sons Mosco Arnolds
John Arnolds and Thomas Arnolds whole and sole Executors
my last will I Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this Sixteenth day of September are the years
seven hundred and seventy four.

It is to be observed that the William F. Arnolds
Words Acres of Land between the Sixth
and seventh lines was intended before the
Will was signed.

therein and ordered to be Recorded and on the motion of the

was granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due
form giving Security. Whereupon they together with
John Haughton and Benjamin their Secretaries entered into
Bonds according to Law.
