equally among my children for their lives & then to be divided equally among
my grand children after their decease.

I am I constitute and appoint my sons William & Jeremiah with my wife
my executors & executrix.

I am I disavow & make void all former wills & testaments as writings
& records I have set my hand & seal this third day of April one thousand
seven hundred & sixty eight.
