

Cumberland County July 26 - 1784 I William Woodson of the
County aforesaid doth make and seal this to be my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following that
Nam I have conveyed to my son Jesse Woodson by a Deed
acknowledged to him for such part of my estate as I have
for him and no more the remainder of my estate now in
possession of Jesse Woodson I give and devise to be equally
divided between my grandson Dancy Woodson the son of Dancy
and my grandson William Woodson the son of Shadrach
I give and devise to Dancy and William one hundred &
twenty five acres of Land part of a Tract that I give
Shadrach Woodson to them and their heirs for ever I nominate
and appoint Dancy Woodson Executor of this my last
Will and Testament Signed sealed and acknowledged in the
presence of

and appoint Daisy Woodson Executor of this my last Will and Testament signed and acknowledged in the presence of us.

At a Court held for Cumberland County 27th June 1785
The last will and Testament of William Woodson deceased

writ of Probate thereof in due form giving security Whereupon he
with Samuel Taylor his security entered into Bond according
