Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give & bequeath the balance of my  
Estate to my Daughter Dillie A. Winfield

Item 5 I give & bequeath to my son in Law  
Richard Winfield my entire interest  
in my sister Sarah Hartly Estate he  
being the adm<sup>r</sup> & I require of him to  
make no returns of that Estate for  
having taken care of me in my  
destitute condition
