

In the name of God, Amen: I Nelson Crowder of the County of Dinwiddie & State of Virginia, being of perfect mind & memory, do make this my last Will & Testament as follows. Viz.

- 1st. I give & bequeath to my friend Joseph A. Byanor & his heirs forever, all the real estate that I now possess, or may hereafter possess by bequest or otherwise.
- 2nd. I give & bequeath to my said friend Joseph A. Byanor, & my friends William Byanor, John T. Byanor & Robert H. Byanor & their heirs forever, all the personal estate that I now possess, or may hereafter possess by bequest or otherwise, to be equally divided among them, share & share alike.
- 3rd. I constitute & appoint my friend John T. Byanor, whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament, & I request the County Court of Dinwiddie not to exact security of him in that capacity, nor to have any appraisement of my estate, as there is no necessity for the one, nor the other.
