nature or kind so ever it may be

3rd After the death of my wife, my
will & desire is, that all of my Estate
be equally divided among my two
daughters Mariah L. Beaman Isena L.
Coleman my grand children

not be entitled to any more of my Estate
under the provisions of this my last will.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute &
appoint my wife Irena Coleman
Executrix of this my last will & Testament
& desire that the Court will not require
of her any security.
