County do make my Last Will and Testament
in form and Manner following —

1st I give ^{my} Daughter Magentt Couper
one Chair Bed and furniture —

2^{dly} I give my Daughter Sarah Couper
the second Chair of my Bed and furniture

3^{dly} I give to my son Abraham Couper
the third Chair of my Bed and furniture

4^{thly} to my two Daughters before mentioned

I give, to Magentt one Desk, and one
Breakfast, to Sarah one Square Walnut
Table, one pair and Iron, or Looking
glass, and three flax Chair —

5^{thly} my Retching furniture is to be equally
divided between my two Daughters be-
fore named — or they or their Guardians
may best agree —

6^{thly} all the Test and Residue of my Estate
Real and Personal, Either in possession
Remainder or Reversion — I wish may be
sold, Except one large China Bowl which
I give my son Abraham, and the
money arising from the sale of the

Payment of my Just Debts, which I
will may be paid I give in the following
proportion Viz. My Daughters, before men-
tioned to receive two Shillings each for every
one Shilling which my before mentioned Son
received - -

Lastly I nominate and appoint my Brother
James Latimer Esq. to take my
Last will and Testament - given
under my hand and seal this the 26-
of January 1802 -
