Item I give to my Grandson George Wythe and his heirs for ever a negro girl cald Bilsad.

Item I give to my Granddaughter Mary Wallace a large Silver Tankard and a large Silver ¹⁰⁰⁰spoon

Item I give to my Daughter in Law Martha Wallace a pr. of my best Holland sheets, and a suit of my best Table linen.

Item I give to my Son James Wallace and his heirs for ever all the rest of my Estate personal and Real. whom I appoint my sole Executor. It is further ^{my} Desire that my Estate be not appraised, nor my Executor held to secure
