

In the Name of God Amen, I, Anthony Harkins
 of the Parish of County of Bluz. City, being sick and weak
 of body, but of perfect mind and memory, thank God for
 His name, do make this my last Will and Testament in
 manner and form following VIZ,

First I bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God
 that gave it, hoping through the Merits & Mediation of my
 blessed Saviour to receive remission of my Sins, And my
 body to be decently interred at the discretion of my
 hereafter Named Executors, My will and desires that
 after my Funeral expences and all my just Debts are
 paid, my Estate may be divided as follows—

Item, I give unto my loving Wife Upham Harkins One
 Negro woman named Jenny to her own proper use

Item I leave unto my loving Wife Upham Harkins the
 use of the following Slaves, during her Natural life or
 Widowhood, One negro Man named Jupiter, One Negro
 Girl named Sylva, One Negro Girl named Jenny and
 Negro Girl named Pender & One Negro Boy named
Quack with their future increase

Item I give unto my son James Harkins one young Boy
 named Horro, and all my wearing Apparel, my Gun & Wagon
 One brass Pistole & my Riding Saddle, and my Carpenters
 and Turners Tools

Item I leave unto all my Personal Estate of any kind whatsoever
 not before mentioned, to my loving Wife Upham Harkins
 during Natural life or Widowhood

Item My will and desire is that in case my Wife Upham
Harkins, die or marry, then I give, bequeath the above
 mentioned Slaves except the Negro Woman Jenny as follows

Item I give unto my son James Harkins One Negro Man
 named Jupiter to him & his Heirs forever

Item My father Will of Duvira is that the following is
 Sylvia, Jenny & Pender with their Future Intmar, and
 all my Personal Estate of any kind ~~Whatsoever~~, be at the
 Death or Marriage of my Wife Uphan Hawthins, equally
 divided between my three Youngest Children VVH
 Anthony Hawthins, John Hawthins, & Richard
 Hawthins

Item My Will dears is that my Loving Wife Uphan
 Hawthins have the liberty of purchasing that Land
 of William Allen's that I have a Mortgage on when
 sold, out of the Money arising from my Personal Estate
 and I lend the use of the said Land unto My said Wife
 during her Natural life or Widowhood in case she
 purchase it, and at her Death or Marriage I give
 the said Land, & Negro boy Luash unto my Son
 William Hawthins to him & his heirs forever

And Lastly I Constitute and appoint my Loving Wife
 Uphan Hawthins my Whole and Sole Executrix of
 this my last will and Testament, revoking and
 making Void all other Wills or Wills by me heretofore
 made Recreating this to be my last Will and Testament
 in Witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 Seal this nineteenth Day of April One thousand
 Seven hundred & Seven by
