 dain this my last Will and Testament in man-
 ner and form following (Via)

Item I leave unto my loving Wife Ann Moore
 the plantation I now live on with the ap-
 purtenances thereunto belonging during
 her life and after her decease I give it to
 my Son William Moore and his heirs with
 the proviso that he will give to my Son Aug-
 ustine Moore the fifty Acres Land I formerly
 gave him be it more or less with the ap-
 purtenances thereunto belonging and in
 case my Son William Moore will not com-
 ply with this my request Then I give to
 my Son Augustine Moore the aforesaid
 plantation lent to my loving Wife Ann
 Moore during her life to him and his
 heirs with the proviso he will pay to my Son
 Merritt Moore the sum of fifty pounds
 current money of Virginia after my decease
 Item I leave unto my loving Wife Ann Moore
 all my Negroes that I shall die possessed
 of during her life and after her decease
 and my debts are paid the remainder
 to be equally divided between my Son Nathaniel
 Moore, my Son John Moore, my Daughter
 Anne Moore, my Daughter Jane Moore, and
 my Son-in-law George Booker share and
 share alike

From I send unto my Loving Wife Ann Moore
all my personal estate whatsoever during
her life and after her decease to go to the
payments of my debts
Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my
Loving Wife Ann Moore to be my Executrix
and my son William Moore, and my son
Merritt Moore, to be my Executors of
this my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking and making void all former
will or Wills heretofore by me made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my Seal this
ninth day of November Anno Domini
one thousand seven hundred and
ninety three
