I give and Bequeath all the Land & my Estate whatsoever
with my Wearing Apparel to my Loving Daughter
Margarette Davis and her Heirs forever —

And lastly do hereby Appoint my Son in Law
Captain William Davis my whole and Sole Executor
to the my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all other
and former Wills hitherto by me made In Witnes whereof
I have hereunto sett my Hand and Seal this 27th day of
September 1762
