Item. I give to my friend of kinman Thomas Jones
 all the residue of my Estate both Real & Personal
 also to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly. I nominate and appoint my friend
 of kinman Thomas Jones Executor of this my last
 Will & Testament, hereby revoking all other Wills
