hereafter named, And as to my Worldly Estate I give
and dispose of in manner and form following

First my Will and desire is that all my just
Debts should be Punctually and Honestly paid

Secondly I give and Bequeath unto my Beloved
Wife Elizabeth Jones my whole Estate both Real
and Personal to her and heirs for Ever

Also I do hereby constitute, Nominate & Appoint
my beloved Wife my Whole and Sole Executor of
this my Last Will and Testament Nullifying &
Confirming this and no other to be my Last Will
& Testament, In WITNESS hereof I have hereunto
set my Hand and Affixed my Seal the Day &
Year above Written

At a Court continued and held for Elizabeth City County
Friday May 27th 1785

This Will was produced in Court and proved by the Oath of
the Witnesses, viz the Coures Ordered to be Recorded
and at a Court held for Elizabeth City County Thursday June 23rd
1785. The Exec^r in the Will named relinquished her Executorship there
of in writing produced to the Court And on the Motion of Edward
Conroy who made Oath according to Law Certificate is granted him
for obtaining Letters of Administration of the Estate of Charles

Jones did upon his giving security
whereupon he together with Tho. Witten
of Richard Barron his Securities entered
into and acknowledged Bond in the penalty
of £1000 conditioned as the Law di-
rects. &c
