 by my Executors hereafter mentioned and as for my worldly Goods after my
 Just Debts is paid I give in manner following - I do give and bequeath
 unto my loving Daughter Martha Davidson the Plantation known live in
 to her and the heirs of her: To D^y, and in case she should dy without issue
 then I give and bequeath the above said Plantation to my loving friend
 John Allen to him and his heirs for ever, and I give and bequeath unto my
 loving Daughter Martha Davidson at the end of my Estate what I have to her
 and her heirs for ever & if she should dy without such heir I give it
 to my loving friend John Allen to him & his heirs for ever and my last wish
 is that my loving friend John Allen keep my Daughters Estate whole
 she shall come of Age or Marry, and I do hereby make and appoint my
 loving friend John Allen my whole & sole Executor of this my last will &
 Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 2^d day of May 1745
