Memory, do make this my last Will, and
Testament, in manner and form following, ^{That}
I give unto my loving Son Wilson Wallace Bayley
after all my just debts are paid, four
Negros, ^{viz} Lucy, Rachel, Tom, & Claban
to him, and to his heirs forever, & in Case he
never has Lawful issue, and at his Death
then my Will and desire is, that the four
Negros above Named, be Equally divided
between my Loving Daughter Elizabeth
Wallace Bayley, and Rachel Mallory
my Sister, I also give unto my Son
Wilson Wallace Bayley, all my stock of
Cattle consisting of Nine Head of Cows, & Yearlings
& five Head of Hogs, also all my household and
kitchen furniture, I also give my said Son my
horse, & a Bond due me, from Mr Francis Riddleton
in Hampton amounting to Eight Pounds - I my
further Will and desire is that, at my said
Sons Wilson Wallace Bayley's Death all the
stock of Cattle & Hogs with three Meads, together
with the furniture be Equally divided between my said
Daughter Elizabeth Wallace Bayley, and my
Sister Rachel Mallory, ^{and my Son Wilson Wallace Bayley, my Executors}
I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed my
seal this 27th. day of November 1792.
