to my Grand-Daughter Easter Whiting Minson Daughter
of Thomas Minson two neg^r Girls named Betty and Molly
Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson Barnister
Minson the piece of Land called Burvis' Land Item
I give and bequeath to my Overseer Samuel White for
his Life the House he now lives in and three Acres of
Land about the House Item I give and bequeath to my
serv^ts Joseph Walley and Alice Walley their freedom and
their Living on the Land called Whiting's Landing for
seven Years after my Decease for them to manure to their
Benefits during that time Item I give and bequeath to
my Son Thomas Minson all my other Goods chattels
Houses Orchards or Estate whatever He paying my
Lawfull Dotts, moreover I do Nominate and Appoint
my S^r Son Thomas Minson as Executor to this my S^r Will
