Item to my Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne ~~the sum of~~ £1000 to
 be paid to me by my Uncle John Mallory living in England. Where
 by I Intend my largest part of the said Legacy to be the
 of one Hundred and thirty six pounds Virginia Currency as be it more
 fully appears my said Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne may Receive to
 him and his heirs for ever provided that my said Son in Law
 Hawthorne do pay or cause to be paid to my Daughter Ann Dear the
 Sum of forty pounds Virginia Currency out of the Legacy above
 to support my said Daughter Ann Dear when Needfull wants but
 if in Case my Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne should not Receive the
 Mentioned Legacy then my Daughter Ann Dear shall Have no Claim
 for the forty pounds aforesaid said Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne
 Ann I Give my said Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne to pay out of the
 Mentioned Legacy Given to me to my Grandson Mallory Hope the Sum of
 thirty pounds at the Age of Twenty one years

Item I Give to my Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne one Negro Woman
 Named Bear to him and his heirs for ever and, my Debts and funeral
 Charges being paid I Give all the Remainder of my Estate to my
 said Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne excepting one Mass Colt which
 I Give to my Grandson w^m Bear Revolin and Disposing all other
 Will by me heretofore made and lastly I nominate and appoint
 my Son in Law Anthony Hawthorne my whole Ex. to this my
 last Will and Testament in W^hose Witness I have hereunto set my
 hand & Seal this 20 of Sep^r 1756 -
