in the House and Twenty five pounds in Mr
Jacob Wray's hands, a Bond of Henry Roberson
for fifteen pounds, and a Note of hand of Thomas
Gordons for Eighteen pounds, which Money I,
desire shall be delivered to my Executor hereafter
Named and after my Just debts are paid it is
my Will and desire that the balance be Equally
divided between my Loving wife Sarah M'Mamara
and my Daughter Charollotte M'Mamara

Item: It is my will and desire that my Executors do purchase
for my Daughter Charollotte M'Mamara a Young
Negro Girl not Exceeding forty Pounds out of
the part of the Money given her

And lastly I Appoint my Loving Wife Sarah
McNamara and M^r. Francis Jones
166a of Warwick my Executors to this my
Last will & Testament. In Witness
Whereof I have here unto set my hand
and Seal this Twenty Second Day
of January 1774. —
