Armistrong Twenty One pound sterling the Remainder
of what I sold Taff for, My Will and desire is that
my Negro Will & Grace & Divonshire should be sold.
I pay M. George Minson's Debt due. Then I give &
Bequeethe to my Daughter Marycott Throckmorton
Money in James Woods hands: if there money left
of the sale of my Three Negroes I give & Bequeethe it to
my Daughter Scott. Then I Give & Bequeethe to my
Daughter Ann Minson a Negro Girl named Tidiloo
to her & her Heir & ~~all~~ ^{her} Furniture & Three
Kathies ^{clothes} & ^{her} ^{own} ^{clothes} if she dies without Heir. my
desire is that her Estate may go to my Daughter
Scott. Then I lend to my Daughter Mary Randolph a
Negro Boy Will at her Death to my Grandson George
Randolph if he dies without Heir to my Grandson
William Randolph. Then I Give & Bequeethe to my
Daughter Armistrong Two Pound Money in James
Woods hands. I leave M. Jacob Wray & Ann Minson
my Executors. Sealed with my seal & dated this
Ninth of October One Thousand Seven Hundred & Sixty Seven
