 this my last Will and Testament. that is to say principally and
 first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the Hand
 of Almighty God that gave it, And my Body I recommend
 to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial
 nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive
 the same again by the Mighty power of God —

As touching my worldly Estate I give devise and dispose of the same
 in the following manner and form —

first, it is my Will and desire all my personal property be sold to
 discharge my just debts as far as it will go, and that all debts
 due to me be collected and appropriated to the same purpose
 and if after paying my just debts there should be any thing
 remaining the same to be applyed the maintainance of my
 Infant Daughter Ann Pool — Also I give and bequeath
 to my Daughter Ann Pool the House that whereon I now live
 the Rent whereof I do expect will support her during her Infan-
 cy and the premises to remain entirely at her disposal when
 she may marry or come of Age, but in case of her death before
 that time, I give the House and lot above mentioned to my friend
 William Pace and his Heirs forever Whom I also nominate and
 appoint Executor to this my last Will & Testament —
