of my Exors here after named and for what worldly goods I am
possessed of I Dispose of as followeth Item I give to my son
Thomas Banor thirty Shillings also My son Henry Banor
thirty Shillings To Samuel Banor thirty Shillings and
to my Daughter Mary Banor thirty Shillings the said money
above mentioned to be paid by my Exors out of my Estate
I also Do Desire that part of my Land from a wearnet Tree
to the River with my orchard on the River shall be sold
at publick Sale and the said money to Discharge my Debts
and pay the Legacies above mentioned and if the Land
above mentioned Do not pay my Debts and pay what Legacies
I have given my Desire is that my Exors shall sell so much
of my personal Estate as shall pay the same I then Give
to my loving wife Sarah Banor the Remainder part of my Land
during her life and after her Death the said Land to be
sold and the money to be fairly divided to the Children I have
by my present wife Sarah Banor, and all my personal
Estate after my Debts and funeral Charges are paid -
I give to my loving wife Sarah Banor in order to Support
her and her Children she has had by me I Do hereby
nominate and appoint my wife Sarah Banor and Joseph
herby Revoking and making all former wills void
doeth to be my Executors of this my last will Testament
before made by me in witness whereof I have here unto set
my hand and fixed my seal on the twentieth day of february one
thousand seven hundred & fifty eight Signed Sealed and Delivered
by the Testator
