 but of perfect sense & memory praised be almighty
 God for the same calling to mind the uncertainty of this
 Mortal life do therefore make & Ordain this my Last
 Will & Testament in Manner following; Imprimis I give
 and bequeth my Soul to God who gave it me & my body to the
 Earth to be Decently buried at the Direction of my friends
 hereafter mentioned & I do hereby what worldly
 Possessors of an Estate I give & bequeth
 to my Son John Robertson I give & bequeth
 to him to have & enjoy his Heir
 but in Case my Son should die before he comes to
 Age of Twenty one year in that case I give the
 one half of my plantation to my Uncle William
 Pool Senr. that half adjoining to M. Brough land
 and the other half of my Plantation I give to my Aunt
 Jane Lewis wife of John Lewis During her Natural
 life and after her Decease I give her half of the said
 land to her Heir at Law at the time of her Decease
 I give & bequeth to my Daughter Mary Lewis my
 lying on my back & my town of
 being twelve acres & the Decree
 ment with me & my Heir for ever
 them I give & bequeth to my loving wife ~~my wife~~
~~Grace~~ all my Household Goods and my white Mare and
 Side Saddle be itder what the law allowes her also I
 Lend the use and Labour of my Negro Girl Grace to my
 wife During her Natural life & after her Decease
 the P. Negro Girl with her Increase to my Son John Robertson
 untill he arrives to the age of Twenty one year & if my Son
 lives to full age in that case I give my P. Negro Girl
 Grace before lent to my wife to my P. Son & his Heir for
 ever

Item I lend the use of all my Slaves and personal Estate not to be
disposed of to my Son John Robertson untill he arrives to the
full age of Twenty one years and if my Son should live
full age in that Case I give all my Slaves & personal Estate
before lent to my Son to him ^{my son} & his Heirs for ever after
paying all my Just Debts Item In Case my Son should happen
to Die before he Arrives to the full age of Twenty one years
I give the one half of my Negroes to my Uncle William Do
Spart. & the other half of my Negroes I lend to my Aunt
Lewis wife of John ~~Do Spart~~ during her natural life
after her decease I give the same before lent to
Lewis to be divided between all my Aunt Lewis children
In Case my Aunt Lewis should prove to be a boy in the
Case ~~of~~ I give him the one half of my Plantation
that part adjoining Mr. Walkers land also the one half
of my Negroes but if it should prove to be a girl I then give
the one half of my Negroes before lent to my Son John Robertson
but if my Son John should Die before he comes to full age
I give ~~to my Son John~~ all my Estate both real and
Personal to such child if any be & to their Heirs for ever

Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my friend
John my ~~last~~ last will & testamentary executor
& make him my sole executor with full power
made a last will & testamentary executor
Guardian to my Son John Robertson untill he
to the full age of Twenty one years In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & affixed
my Seal at this 30th Day of December 1750
