Revoking all Wills & Codicils, heretofore made & signed do by this my last Will & Testament Announce that all my Property in Land Negroes Chattles are delivered up to my Sons George & John Ashton Wray by deeds & proper documents & that they are in the quiet possession & that also I have delivered up to my Grand daughter Asa Hart - As W Charles & her in full four hundred pound specie Value in Negroes As Jenny & her Children & Miller John the other negroes allotted for them sold by me & delivered for that Use As Elizabeth & Heart & Helen Wray & Heart Equally to be divided & if either die without Issue unmarried or to take possession at twenty one Age the surviving Sister shall be intitled to the other part & if both fail my Grand Son Jacob Wray & Heart & his Heirs to inherit -

As John A. & Heart has also given up to him in full four hundred pound specie Value in Negroes As Milla & her Child even not otherwise disposed of And Grace the other Negroes allotted for him sold by me & the money delivered him which he has promised to give to my Grand Daughter As Nancy Wray & Heart This Child or Daughter
My Will is that a Certificate in my hand due from one of the State of Virginia of more than four hundred pound be Equally divided to my four Grand Daughters As Mary Ann Wray Elizabeth & Heart Helen Wray & Heart & Nancy Wray & Heart

held by me — I do further make con-
stitute and appoint my Son my Executor
to carry this my Will into effect without be-

ninth day of November one thousand eight
hundred and ninety eight
