my Will and desire is that the said Negro Hampton
shall have his Freedom on. Paying Wilson Wallace
Bailey Three Pounds lawfull money Annually, and
in Case of his death, It is my Will and Desire the said
Negro Hampton shall have his freedom
Item I Give my Negro Boy Moses unto Diana Wallace
Bailey During her Widowhood but if she should
Marry, then my Will and desire is that the said
Moses shall then go unto Gill Armistead Son
of Cap^{tn} William Armistead of the S^d County
Item, I Give unto Diana Wallace Bailey my Bed
furniture all my Wearing Apperill my Watch &
horse Saddle & bridle She paying all my Just &
Lawfull Debts; Item I do ordain & appoint Diana
Wallace Bailey my whole and sole Executor of this
my last will & Testament and do hereby revoke and
make Void all other wills and Testaments

Elizabeth City County Court April 28. 1791.

This Will was produced in Court and proved by the Oath of Samuel Cunningham and James Goodwin Ministers there to and ordered to be recorded And on the Motion of Deamach Waller the Executrix therein named who made Oath and signed to have Certificate or grant for obtaining a probat thereof in due Form Thompson esq. together with James Goodwin Esq. John Gifford Esq. and Lewis Esq. entered into and acknowledged Bond with the fees of Three Hundred pounds payable on demand as the Law directs.

July 26. 1791. John Gifford Esq. qualified as Exam. &c. with the Will annexed with Geo. Proctor Secretary.
