the One third part of my apple & Peach Orchards with the Following Horses to wit Molly Sarah Nan Shen Lucy
& Samson Graydon Slaver Gun also my Riding Horse & Chaise & two of my Horses & two Mules, the one half
of my Tricshops & Trench Furniture & the one third part of my stock of Cattle & Hogs, also the third
part of my Crops in being at the time of my decease. Item I give unto my son John Thompson One thousand
Pounds of a good buying in Northampton County in the State of North Carolina to him and his Heirs for ever
After I give & bequeath unto my son John Thompson the my Wife Elizabeth Thompsons deced the 10th wing
Alliance to wit Samson Gun Molly Sarah Nan Shen Lucy & Nan with their Increase & Future increase
to him & his Heirs forever. Item I send unto my Voracious Thompsons all my Lands in Elizabeth City County
(with that Next my Wife still is & Death) together with his Natural life, and after my wife's death I am to keep
Dead I give & bequeath the said Lands that I sent to him in Elizabeth City County unto his heirs forever
Lawful son and his Heirs for ever and in case my son John Thompson should die & leave no issue then I
give the said Lands in Elizabeth City County unto his eldest son of my son John Thompson & his Heirs forever
After I give unto my son John Thompson a piece of Lands lying in York County near Thompsons Mills
to wit of his Heirs forever. Next I give and bequeath unto my son John Thompson after my Wife Elizabeth's decease
Deced the following Negroes to wit Gaudy & Aaron & his Heirs for ever also the cattle sheep things
to wit Henshott & Henshott. After the death of me Wife that I live in &

the other furniture of every kind to greater and less value that shall be upon my

unto my son Robert Remond's all the Negroes of what so ever kind with their families & festival increase which he
is. Now in presence of in Northampton County in the State of North Carolina to him & his heirs for ever
the Freehold of my estate not due before given I give the same to my son Robert Remond's & his heirs
for ever. That I make Robert Remond's & Robert Remond's &
Thomas Smith my son in law Executors of this my last Will & Testament, in witness where of I
have here unto set my hand & seal this twenty six day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred & Eighty seven
