 my Will and Desire that the whole of the above
 Mentioned premises I Give to My said Daughter
 Elizabeth Gay for the same purposes as above
 Mentioned. And I Do hereby Nominate
 and appoint My said Wife Ann Banks
 My whole Executrix of this My Last Will
 and Testament, Rescinding all former Wills
 by me heretofore Made, And Testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set My Hand and Seal this
 third Day of February In the Year of Our Lord
 One thousand Eight hundred and three
