of perfect Sense and Memory I blyss God, and I do
make and ordain this my last Will and Testam^t
and Dispose of my Estate that God has ben pleased
to blyss me with, in Manner and form as followeth
I my selfe Lend unto my loving Wif^e Rebeca Dewbre
my Tract or parzell of Land lying and being
in the County of Warwick, also my tract or
parzell of Land lying and being in the County
of Eliz^t City, with full power to Cutt the
Timber to pay my Debts, I also lend her all
my Negroes, my Stock of all Kindes, my Household
Goods of all sorte, and all my Cash Dues of
her life or the time she remains my Widow
she bringing Maintaining and Schooling my
Chldren.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Thos^r Dewbre
my Tract or parzell of Land lying and being
in the County of Eliz^t City, to him and to his
Heirs lawfully begotten of his Body for ever
Provided the said my loving Wif^e shall think
proper to sell to pay my Debts, which shall be sufficient
ent, if not then my Will and Desire is that my
loving Wif^e do sell and Dispose of the above
said Tract or parzell of Land to come short the
payement of my just Debts, and after that
that is compled with, my Will and Desire
is that the remainder of the Money arising
from the Sale of the above said Land, may
be put to Interest, which Money and the Int.
I give unto my above said Son Thos^r Dewbre
to be paid him when he comes to the age of
Twenty one years of age or Marred to be
to his Heirs for ever

I am I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
Eliz^t Denbre my Negro Girl Lucy to her and
to her Heirs for Ever

Item My Will and Desire is at the Death or Marriage
of my Loving ^{Wife}, which shall first Happen, I
Then Will and Desire it that all my Negroes
and all my other Estate In whatsoever
Denomination it may Convey or may be
Equally Divided between my Son John Denb^t
my Son Thos D^r Denbre and my Daughter Eliz^t
Denbre, to each of them and to each of them
heirs for Ever

Item I do hereby Nominate and Appoint my
Loving Wife Rebecca Denbre Whole and
Sole Exec^t of this my last Will and Testam^t
Rescinding all former Wills by me made.
