when they Come to the age of Eighteen, or when married

Item I Desire that my funerall Charges, & all my other just
debts be first paid, out of my Estate before any legacies
are paid

proffits of my Estate towards the bringing up my
Children, So long as she Remains a widow
& exetis in Care

Item I name & appoint my two loving & friendly friends
to wit Mr Henry Tucker & William Tucker, as Trustees
to see this my last will & testament justly & truly
