 the use of all the residue & remainder of
 my lands during her natural life
 then I give and bequeath to my Nephew Hugh
 Moore son of Wm Moore the above mentioned
 land and his heirs lawfully begotten

I give and bequeath unto Ann Armistead
 wife of James Armistead my Negro

 I give & bequeath unto my daughter
 Elizabeth the said two Negroes
 Jupiter & George & her heirs
 and as full use & fruit there in my

 and George to my Nephew Augustin
 Moore to him & his heirs lawfull
 begetton

I give & bequeath unto my dear wife
 Elizabeth my two Negroes Phillis
 and Francis to her & her heirs law-
 fully begotten for ever.

I give unto my loving wife Ann Moore
my best and whole share of all I have
and the remainder of my stock of whatever kind
I give to be equally divided between my wife
Ann Moore & my daughter Eliza Moore, after
my debts are paid out of the same.

authorizing and making void all other Wills
