weak but of perfect mind and memory do make this  
my last will and Testament first I Commit my  
Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it  
and my Body to be lawfully Buried by the Clergy as  
for any worldly good that he has pleased God to bless me  
with I give and devise as followeth

I give first I give unto my Daughter in Law Jane Robinson  
my Negro woman named Yellow Hamlet to her for ever  
likewise I give to my said Daughter in Law the best  
load and the furniture that I have except the best  
snow cap and our coat and Calfs our pot and hook  
and our gold ring which she has now on her hand and all  
her own Mobbins Clothes

I give and devise unto my Kinsman James Robertson  
son of my Brother James Robertson if he be now living  
that half lot of land where his said father  
lived on to him and his heirs for ever but if the said  
James Robertson should be dead then I give the said  
half lot of land unto his sister Jane Robinson and her  
heirs for ever

I give and devise unto my sister Rebecca Rolph one acre of  
land and land to land four thousand Corn hills upon  
that point for use to Maj<sup>r</sup> Swearing Nitch by the  
water side during his life and one half of Corn

I give and devise all the remainder of my Estate both  
Real and personal unto my son Henry Robertson to him  
and his heirs for ever and if my said son Henry Robinson  
should dye before he should come to the age of twenty one  
years then I give all my Estate both Land and Chattels  
to be equally divided between my Kinsman William  
Robinson William Miller and Samuel that Robinson  
Harris if he be living the son of Eleanor Harris do  
to them and their heirs for ever and if any of  
of the said persons or any should dye without heirs  
then the Survivors should have the whole Estate before  
mentioned my will and desire is that my Cattel hogs and  
sheep should not be sold but shall be kept on my lands  
with my negroes for the benefit of my son and I do  
Constitute and appoint Mr. William Westmore and

and Mr John Bldon and Robert Brough my  
whole Executors of this my last will and Testament  
and Gading to my son Henry Robinson watching  
all other wills and testaments whatsoever as witness  
my hands and seal this 19<sup>th</sup> of December 1747
