 Rose after the death of his mother to him and his heirs lawfully Begotten

them I give to my son John Sheppard fear Anger sleeping need Cotte and Charlot I give them to him after the death of his mother I give them to him

I gave to my daughter Ann smelt a Ring and furnished one gold Ring and one pair of gold ^{ear} rings of Bobs
 Shearstone gave her

Give to my daughter ^{the} sister low Negroes pill and due to her and her heirs Lawfully Begotten

them agree to my daughter's wish - Sheppard's two Negroes take up a room and one bed and furniture to her and her heirs
Lawfully begotten

Then give to my Daughters Jean Sheppard's two Negroes Sam and Edet and one bed and furniture to her and her heirs Lawfully Begotten

time I send to John Smith the plantation formerly bought of Peter Davis during his North life and after his death I give it to my granddaughter Elizabeth Smith to her and her heirs lawfully begotten of her own body and if she should die without heirs as afore said then give it to my son John Sheppard and likewise give to my granddaughter Elizabeth Smith a Negro woman named marian and if my granddaughter should die without heirs as afore said then
