Now I Give to my Daughter in law Mrs. Mary Berry
formerly wife to my son Charles Skinner of Shilling
to be in full of her ^{christened} share of my Estate
Now I Give to my Sons William John Henry
Nicholas and Thomas Skinner and to my Grand
son Charles Skinner and to my Daughter Robert
Coys and Eliz. Wilson all the Rest of my Estate
that before Given away to be Equally Divided
amongst them Except my Wif^s man will which
I Give to my son Thomas Skinner
Lastly I Promise and appoint this to be my last will
and Testament Revoking and Disannulling all
former wills by me made and Do appoint and

Constitute and ordain my Law in Law
Robert Croft and Thomas Wilson to be my
Whole and Sole Exors of this my last will and
